

ACCESSING THE OAG NETWORK REMOTELY FROM AN OAG ISSUED WINDOWS 7 SYSTEM

In order to successfully access the secure OAG network from any location, you must have an **Internet Connection** (e.g. Internet Explorer).


STEPS TO ACCESS OAG NETWORK REMOTELY:

- 1) Connect to the internet via your Internet Service Provider (ISP)
- 2) Open your internet browser and enter in the following *secured* address:

https://agnet.oag.state.va.us

- 3) A Security Alert box may appear. Please click **Add this site to your Trusted Sites list, and always allow inspection from this site** to continue, or

If you are using an older version of Internet Explorer, a Security Alert box may appear to view pages over a secure connection. Select **OK** to continue.




- 4) When you receive the Internet Explorer Security box asking “a website wants to open web content using this program on your computer,” check “**Do not show me the warning for this program again**” and click **Allow** to continue, or


A Security Alert box may display asking to accept the certificate. Select **Yes** to continue.




- 5) The secured F5 OAG login page will be displayed. Enter your OAG user ID and Password, then click **Logon**.



- 6) Once connected, the remote access (F5) connection will display in the taskbar in the lower right hand corner of your screen.



- 7) When your desktop appears, you will be able to access the programs on the desktop (as if you were in the office).
- 8) When you have completed your work and are ready to disconnect, please logout of the remote F5 VPN connection by clicking on the F5 icon in the taskbar, and the clicking **Logout** on the F5 menu.



Notes:

- Users will be logged out of F5 after 15 minutes of inactivity. Session inactivity timeouts are part of the OAG standard data security practices.
- If a local printer has been installed, you will be able to print locally to that printer.
- If an OAG networked printer has been installed, you will be able to send print jobs to the OAG networked printers.
